I am qualified and interested in the following inspector categories:

- CLINICAL CELLULAR THERAPY PROGRAM**
Inspector must be a licensed physician and have a minimum of two years experience in cellular therapy product administration.
- APHERESIS COLLECTION FACILITY**
Inspector must have a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), nursing, or biological science degree and have completed formal fellowship training in apheresis or at least one year experience in peripheral blood progenitor cell collection by apheresis as the director, physician, nurse, technician supervisor, or assistant supervisor.
- BONE MARROW COLLECTION FACILITY**
Inspector must be qualified as either a clinical program inspector or an apheresis collection facility inspector. Inspections of the marrow collection facility performed by personnel without a doctoral degree will be performed in conjunction with the M.D. inspecting the clinical and/or facilities of the same program.
- CELL PROCESSING FACILITY**
Inspector must hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), biological science, or medical technologist degree [B.S, M.T. (ASCP or AMT), CLS (NCA), SBB, etc.] and have at least two years experience as a Processing Director, Medical Director or Supervisor of a Cell Processing Facility.
- CORD BLOOD BANK TEAM LEADER/BANK INSPECTOR**
Inspector must hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.) degree and have five years experience in cord blood banking and/or transplantation; or be an active FACT clinical and/or bank inspector experienced with cord blood transplantation.
- CORD BLOOD BANK COLLECTION FACILITY**
Inspector must hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), nursing, or biological science and have at least one year experience as the director or supervisor of a CBB; or be an active FACT clinical and/or collection inspector of a cellular therapy program. JACIE Inspectors are also qualified to inspect CBB collection facilities.
- CORD BLOOD BANK PROCESSING FACILITY**
Inspector must hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), biological science, or medical technologist degree [B.S, M.T. (ASCP or AMT), CLS (NCA), SBB, etc.] and have at least two years experience as a Processing Director, Medical Director, or Supervisor of a Cell Processing Facility or Cord Blood Bank. JACIE Inspectors are also qualified to inspect CBB processing facilities.

FACT INSPECTORS

Qualifications: The following are the minimum criteria for an inspector:

1. The inspector shall be an individual member of ISCT, ISCT-Europe, ASBMT, ASFA, EBMT, or NetCord.
2. Each inspector shall be affiliated with a Program that is accredited by FACT, FACT-NetCord, or JACIE or has submitted its initial Application Form and fee for accreditation.
3. The inspector shall document that she or he is qualified by training and experience to perform the FACT on-site inspection.
4. An inspector of a Clinical Cellular Transplant Program shall hold a medical degree and have a minimum of two years experience in cellular therapy product administration.
5. An inspector of an Apheresis Collection Facility shall hold a relevant doctoral degree (M.D. or Ph.D.), nursing, or biological science degree and have completed formal fellowship training in apheresis or at least one year experience in peripheral blood progenitor cell collection by apheresis as the director, physician, nurse, technician supervisor, or assistant supervisor.
6. An inspector of a Bone Marrow Collection Facility shall be qualified as either a clinical transplant program inspector or an apheresis collection facility inspector. Inspections of the marrow collection facility performed by personnel without a doctoral degree will be performed in conjunction with the M.D. inspecting the clinical and/or laboratory of the same program.
7. An inspector of a Cell Processing Facility shall hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), biological science, or medical technologist degree [B.S, M.T. (ASCP or AMT), CLS (NCA), SBB, etc.] and have at least two years experience as a Processing Director, Medical Director or Supervisor of a Cell Processing Facility.
8. An inspector serving as the Cord Blood Bank (CBB) Team Leader/Bank Inspector shall hold a relevant doctoral degree (M.D. or Ph.D.) and have at least five years of experience in cord blood banking and/or transplantation; or be an active FACT clinical or CBB inspector with experience in cord blood transplantation.
9. An inspector of a Cord Blood Bank (CBB) Collection Facility shall hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), nursing, or biological science and have at least one year experience as the director or supervisor of a CBB; or be an active FACT clinical and/or collection inspector of a cellular therapy program. JACIE Inspectors are also qualified to inspect CBB collection facilities.
10. An inspector of a Cord Blood Bank (CBB) Processing Facility must hold a relevant doctoral (M.D. or Ph.D.), biological science, or medical technologist degree [B.S, M.T. (ASCP or AMT), CLS (NCA), SBB, etc.] and have at least two years experience as a Processing Director, Medical Director, or Supervisor of a Cell Processing Facility or Cord Blood Bank. JACIE Inspectors are also qualified to inspect CBB processing facilities.
11. Each inspector shall have completed successfully a training course for new inspectors, and the ongoing periodic inspector training modules as prepared by the Accreditation Committee.
12. The FACT Board may in their joint discretion approve an inspector with a shorter duration of experience if the individual is otherwise qualified to be an inspector.
